MARIN COUNTY COMMISSION ON AGING (Division of Aging and Adult Services)

The Marin County Commission on Aging is a 23-member federally mandated advisory council to the Marin County Board of Supervisors. Commissioners are appointed to three-year terms by either the Board of Supervisors or the 11 incorporated Cities and Towns in Marin. According to the Older Americans Act, membership shall be composed of: (a) a majority of persons 60 years or older; (b) service providers; (c) members who reflect the geographic, racial, economic, and social complexion of the

area they represent; and (d) at least one member who represents the interests of the disabled. Novato makes one appointment to the Commission.

MARIN COUNTY AVIATION COMMISSION

The Marin County Aviation Commission advises and recommends to the Board of Supervisors on matters relating to Marin County Airports, regulations of private airports, cooperation with military airports, and all other aviation matters. There are seven members and no specific qualifications are required for appointment. One appointment is made by the Board of Supervisors from each Supervisorial District; two appointments representing the Greater Novato area, one to be nominated by the Novato City Council. No more than four members shall be active pilots, aircraft owners, or connected with aviation business.

MOSQUITO AND VECTOR CONTROL DISTRICT

The Marin/Sonoma Mosquito & Vector Control District is committed to protecting the health and welfare of the communities served from mosquitoes and vector-borne disease. The District is governed by a Board of Trustees. Each member represents a city or county at large. Trustees are appointed by their city council or county board of supervisors and serve a four year term. Each member of the Board appointed by the governing body of a city/town shall be an elector of the city or town from which he/she is appointed, and a resident of that portion of the city/town which is in the District.
