- 3. Authorize staff to file a Notice of Preparation under CEQA




# NOVATO BLVD. PROJECT BACKGROUND

- A Countywide Congestion Management Plan (CMP) was prepared in the early 2000's
- The CMP projected Novato Blvd. to fall below operational standards in the future
- City evaluated existing conditions in consideration of issues
- To address issues, a 5-lane layout was proposed and an EIR was started
- Further progress was slowed by the recession & limited staff resources
- Consultant team has been hired to complete the project




## 5-LANE LAYOUT – CURRENT PREFERRED ALTERNATIVE

- Maintains two through-lanes in each direction
- New connector street between Pine Avenue and Cypress Avenue
- Sidewalks and Bicycle Lanes also included




#### **5-LANE OPTION: PINE & CYPRESS CONNECTOR**




### NEW 3-LANE LAYOUT - RECOMMENDED


- One through-lane in each direction between Diablo Ave. & Boulevard Terrace
- Two lanes northbound from Boulevard Terrace through Grant Ave.
- Continuous center turn lane for access to driveways and side streets
- Sidewalks and Bicycle Lanes included from Grant Ave. to Diablo Ave.



#### 3-LANE OPTION: SOUTH END




#### 3-LANE OPTION: BOULEVARD TER. - 7<sup>TH</sup>/TAMALPAIS

### 3-LANE & 5-LANE LAYOUT COMPARISON

#### **Current 5-Lane Layout**

#### **Recommended 3-Lane Layout**

Removes approx. 51 mature trees

Wider "footprint" may impact Novato Creek

Acquires land from 27+ properties

Demolishes at least 3 houses

Preliminary cost estimate: \$20-25M

Removes approx. 28 mature trees

Narrower "footprint" avoids Novato Creek

Acquires land from approx. 6 properties

No houses are demolished

Preliminary cost estimate: \$10-15M



## TRAFFIC ANALYSIS

#### Level of Service (LOS) analysis during peak traffic hours:



- Traffic projected to year 2043 assuming full buildout of General Plan
- Traffic volumes increase by 21-23 percent over existing volume



# ALTERNATIVE TRAFFIC CONDITIONS

#### Current Conditions

- Generally LOS D during peak hours
- Drivers making left turns onto side streets or driveways can cause LOS E/F

#### Future (2043) "No Project"

- LOS F Violates City's General Plan policies
- Violates TAM's Congestion Management Plan policies

#### Future with 3-Lane Layout

- LOS D with more stable flow than today
- Left-turning vehicles will no longer block through traffic

#### Future with 5-Lane Layout

 LOS C - Stable flow during peak hours



# INTERIM IMPROVEMENTS

Improvements planned for Novato Blvd. between Diablo and Grant:

- "Keep Clear" legends on Novato Blvd. at Pine Ave. and Cypress Ave.
- New or relocated "No Outlet" signs to deter cut-through traffic
- Extension of northbound right turn lane from Novato Blvd. to 7<sup>th</sup> St.
- Placement of channelizers along the shoulders between Fawn Ct. and Pine Ave.
- Minor tree pruning near the north end of Los Alondras Ct.
