Supplemental Web Survey

After the results of the mailed-survey (sent to a randomly-selected sample of 3,000 residents) were collected, the supplemental web-survey was made available on the City of Novato website. This survey (identical to the mailed-survey) was open to all residents and non-residents of Novato who wanted to participate. Over a ten-day period, 98 responds were collected.

The results are NOT statistically-significant.

ABOUT THIS REPORT

As part of its participation in The National Citizen Survey™ (The NCS), the City of Novato conducted a mailed survey of 3,000 residents. Surveys were mailed to randomly selected households in February and March and data was collected through April. After the official data collection period was over and the data were reported (see the report, *The National Citizen Survey: City of Novato, Report of Results 2013*), the City made available the Web-based survey to its residents through a link on the City's Web site. Visitors to the site were able to complete the survey during May and 98 surveys were received.

This report contains the results of this administration of the Web-based survey and have not been weighted to current population estimates of the City.
