Survey Purpose

- The goal of the survey was to provide information on citizen attitudes on a broad range of issues covered by the General Plan.
- Given the limitations of a survey of this type, many issues were not covered so that a few key issues could be probed in some depth.
- Many of the issues covered in the study are very complex. The survey is designed to evaluate overall "top-of-mind" attitudes and values today.
- The survey does not assess the adequacy of city services.
- It does not measure reactions to additional information or changes in the city that may come about during the General Plan update process.



Methodology

- Telephone survey
- Random digit dial of residents aged 18 and over in the City of Novato
- 602 interviews
- Margin of error <u>+</u> 4.0 percentage points
- Conducted March 15-21, 2009
- Respondents demographically balanced to match Novato's adult population.
- Available in English or Spanish
- Trained, Professional interviewers



Novato Population Distribution






Key Findings

- Residents are happy with how things are going, both in the City of Novato and in their own neighborhood.
- Priorities include maintenance of public safety services, open space and natural habitat preservation, environmentalism, and economic growth.
- In planning for the future, residents think that transportation and infrastructure issues are most important to consider, followed by schools, then growth and development.
- While housing development is a low priority for most, multi-family and mixed-use developments are a good fit with the priorities of the population (environmentalism, transit orientation, downtown revitalization).
- North Redwood Boulevard holds potential as a mixed-use area, with restaurants and retail stores holding the most appeal.






Maintaining public safety services is a top priority, along with open space, streets and sidewalks, and economic growth






While housing development is at the bottom of the priority list, it is not strongly opposed






Priority: Environment, parks & recreation, Community programs






Priority: Transportation, traffic, public safety






Priority: Housing, development






Most Novato residents prefer allowing more retail development to raising taxes

How would you prefer the city to fund maintaining or increasing city services?




