## A. Signs

Signs made at a work party, some out in the field were swapped out. Another work event will occur on May 8.

- B. Island/Park Adoption
- 1. Island/Park Updates -5-6 applications are out. Ed is going to follow-up on them.
- 2. Number adopted past month = 0
- 3. Streetscape Committee Island Marcia went out to the island with Clive discuss next steps. A sign placed on the island had damaged the irrigation and repairs are needed. A problem with the irrigation is that this island has been modified several times and the irrigation lay-out is all over the place. Also, there are valves only on the ends of the island, and sprinklers have been damaged by mowing. The irrigation lines are laid out in a grid pattern. Staff needs an idea of what the plan is for a planting pattern, so it lines up with the irrigation. There are logistical issues with the water delivery system. Some plants will probably be donated by CNPS.

McNair Island does not have water. City would have to cut a trench into the roadway to access a water source.

Idea for next year: Send C&G posters to businesses that have received recognition – perhaps they will participate, and/or post the flyers.
