

Hook Ramps on & off US 101	
Connect Rush Landing Rd. into American Assets	●
Create Ped/Bike Connection between Wood Hollow and Fireman's Fund	●
Roundabout at Redwood/Rush Landing Rd.	●
Modify Redwood/San Marin intersection and U.S. 101 interchange to improve traffic flow	●
Accepting longer queues if it means adding fewer lanes

“Hook Ramp” offramp from SB 101 onto Redwood Blvd.




“Hook Ramp” onramp onto NB 101 from Rush Landing Road
