B.Cochran presented the draft Measure F Report to the Committee and highlighted some of the changes from previous years. This year's report discusses what projects and services have been funded by Measure F and what the impacts and outcomes of those programs have been. The layout showcases more of a brochure than a report with pull quotes, text boxes and pictures (to be added in the final draft). The Committee provided staff with feedback to the report. Some committee members expressed the desire to remove the Fiscal Sustainability language focusing on the need for on-going revenue, some of the hyperbole should be changed and a closing comment should be added expressing concern about the increase in City's budgeted expenditures that returns the City to a deficit position. Each Committee member will provide staff with specific edits to be incorporated in the final draft. The Chair is tentatively scheduled to present the final report to the City Council on September 23 or 30.
