C. Stewart updated the Committee on the economic development efforts including effects of the Shop Local Campaign on small businesses, increases in sales tax revenue and improvements in sales tax leakage in Novato. Committee member Bentley asked if the City should continue the investment in the Shop Local campaign as the incremental sales tax generated was \$30k

less than the City's investment. Committee member Berson asked about business vacancy rates in Novato and what was being done to make Novato special. The City has an overall 3.5% retail 24% office space vacancy rate. C. Stewart explained Novato is special because of the Buck Center, three pharmacy and drug company leaders and the top five bio life science companies.
