Ed suggested that a call to Auto Works and Siemens should be placed before sending a letter (intent to pull their sign) to them.

Janey McAdams wanted to know, how long is the approval process for adopting an Island?

Tom informed Janey McAdams that it may take a longer time to approve the island she is interested, because it is such a big island.

D. Public Outreach

On March 28, 2015, Marcia set up a table in front of Pini Hardware to inform the public of Clean & Green Day and about Novato Streetscape Committee and what their functions are. Eleven people left their names and phone numbers expressing their interest. Also, numerous persons took postcards concerning the Clean & Green Day event.

While Marcia was at Pini Hardware, Dawn Carlson (may have a promotion company) came up to the table and mentioned the Tree City USA program that is put on by the Arbor Day Foundation. Marcia will get in touch with Dawn Carlson for more information on the Tree City USA program.

Marcia, in addition, to the Farmers Market table that the Committee has, she would like to do more tables throughout the year.

Len stated, that the Committee could do a better job as far as sponsorship is concern. Also, the committee would not only be helped by sponsorships, but the community would benefit as well.

E. Signs

Ed requested that if there are any priority locations that signs need to go up, please let him know and he will post the Adopt-N-Island signs. Ed has 8 or 10 signs that can be place on islands for adoption. Ed suggested to Tom maybe when the crew is out they might see where Adopt-N-Island signs could be placed.

Len says, we should look at the condition of the signs we have first.

Janey McAdams requested a sign to be placed at both of the ends of the island she wants to adopt.

Ed informed Janey McAdams that the signs for the adopt-n-island are \$1400.00 each.

Len suggested that the Committee should take a look at the island that Janey McAdams is interested in adopting.
