Notice is hereby given that the City of Novato Design Review Commission will conduct a public hearing on **Wednesday, December 16, 2015, at 7:30 p.m.** at the Novato City Hall, 901 Sherman Avenue, to consider approving exterior finish materials, colors, fixtures (lighting etc.), landscaping, and bicycle racks for a complete renovation to the bus facility along Redwood Boulevard, between Grant and DeLong Avenues, in Downtown Novato proposed by Marin Transit. The overall facility renovations, which include a new shelter design and associated bus/pedestrian circulation pattern were approved by City Council on August 25, 2015.

As the Lead Agency approving and constructing the proposed project, Marin Transit has determined the project to be exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Sections 15301, 15302 and 15332.
