

Brian Cochran, Finance Manager, informed the Committee of the main initiatives and projects underway: the FY 15/16 audit will be completed by year-end and will be presented to the Committee following Council approval, the possibility of new financial auditors in 2019, a city wide user-fee study to determine full benefited average cost of fees, updating technology in various departments including the installation of a new financial accounting system, records management and a computerized maintenance management system. Many improvements have already taken place in the Police Department. B. Cochran suggested the Information Technology Manager give a presentation to the Committee regarding these improvements and upcoming projects. Also discussed was the possibility of creating a pension trust to be more pro-active regarding future PERS costs.



D. Bentley suggested that regularly occurring reviews of financial statements and reports be added to their Committee responsibilities. There was also discussion to include the review of proposed expenditures on a regular basis, accountability for Measure C Funds versus General Funds spending and the fiduciary obligation to oversee how those funds are spent. The Committee also discussed the difference between advisory and advocacy.

#### Novato Citizens Finance Advisory / Oversight Committee - Mission, Role, and Responsibilities

#### **Committee Mission:**

The mission of the Committee is as follows:

- 1. Provide advice and feedback to City staff and the City Council on a variety of financial matters, including but not limited to, financial policies, annual budgets, forecasts, etc.
- 2. Review the expenditures of remaining Measure F transactions and use tax funds and provide an annual report to the community on such expenditures, until remaining funds are fully expended.
- 3. Provide an annual report to the community on the revenues and expenditures of Measure C transactions and use tax funds; if such funds are deposited into the General Fund of the City, the report may take the form of a General Fund-wide annual report of activities and expenditures.

#### Committee Role:

The committee shall be advisory to the City Council and shall not have an advocacy role.

#### <u>Citizens Finance Advisory Responsibilities:</u>

- 1. Review existing fiscal policies from time-to-time and/or recommend new fiscal policies to the City Council; including guidelines for the use of fund balances, surpluses and other reserves.
- 2. Review budget assumptions and budget process.
- 3. Review the City's General Fund financial forecast regularly.
- 4. Review the financial status of other funds from time-to-time as appropriate.
- 5. Collaborate with City staff to determine long-term financial needs, obligations, and funding strategies to achieve long-term sustainability.
- 6. Collaborate with staff on strategies to encourage public information and communication regarding the City's financial situation and options for improving the City's financial health.

#### Measure F Oversight Responsibilities:

- 1. Review the proposed expenditures from Measure F during the annual budget process and provide feedback.
- 2. Review Measure F expenditure proposals that arise during the fiscal year and provide feedback.
- 3. Review and report annually on the expenditure of Measure F transactions and use tax funds, and make the report available to the public.

#### Measure C Oversight Responsibilities:

1. Review and report annually on the revenues and expenditures of Measure C transactions and use tax funds, and make the report available to the public.
