It is a public document and is available upon request. The policy includes the established guidelines and criteria for improvements to crosswalks. A priority list will be used to document requests and to determine order of improvements. Due to the cost, Grants are often applied for. Crosswalks can cost \$15,000-20,000 on the low end and go up based on needs. City also matches funds where available. We recently received more grant funding for 5 more crosswalks including George, Sherman, Rush Creek, and McClay Rd.
