E. NEW BUSINESS

1. <u>Hill Recreation Area/Margaret Todd Senior Center Master Plan Capital Improvement Project Presentation</u>. Ms. Shinault gave some background information on this item and introduced project consultant, Mr. Vince Lattanzio, Carducci Associates.

Mr. Lattanzio gave a PowerPoint presentation. He discussed the phases of the project and funding. He asked the Commission for their top three priorities for Phase 1.

The Commission discussed several priority options, such as parking, pickleball courts. They asked for clarification on the cost of Phase 1 and the whole project.

Mr. Lattanzio stated Phase 1 is estimated to cost \$4.5 - \$5 million, to complete the whole project, add \$2 - \$3 million more.

The meeting was open for public comment.

Comments ranged from adding more pickleball courts, parking concerns, number of multipurpose fields, concern for relocation of generator, need for more restrooms, and how it will generate revenue.

The meeting was closed for public comment.

The Commission discussed their concerns and identified the need for more pickleball courts, and how synthetic turf fields are important to help generate revenue.

Commissioner Weber left the meeting at 8:21 pm.

The Commission discussed the cost of only doing Phase 1 versus the whole project.
