

D. PUBLIC COMMENT

Chair Thomas asked for Public Comment – Mayor Athas thanked the Commission for their work and Kevin Morrison introduced himself as a candidate for City Council. Hutch Turner noted that Shop Local might consider taking a wider focus than just retail businesses which generate tax dollars and mentioned that adding legal and other small businesses would be helpful. Councilmember Eklund mentioned that she's working with ABAG to become an Economic Development District that would allow businesses to apply for grants for manufacturing and industrial functions.

E. GENERAL BUSINESS

E – 1 INFORMATION: Shop Local Update and Website Redesign Presentation – Claire Knoles Claire provided the commission and update. The Shop Local site is a tool for educating people about the power of the retail dollars, features local businesses and has a directory

of stores and services to remind folks of what's here. Kiosk provides business outreach help, conducts Hispanic outreach via the Hispanic chamber of Commerce and administers Shop Local.

E – 2 INFORMATION/DISCUSSION: Business Outreach Pilot Program Presentation – Jessica Deakyne

Jessica provided the commission information about this proposed program, answered questions and received feedback. The commissioners were supportive and volunteered to assist with these visits.

F. COMMISSION COMMENTS

- a. Ex-Officio member Barry asked about the Park-A-Pup dog boarding application, asked about the General Plan's update status and noted that Amy's Vegetarian drive-thru is in progress to open in Corte Madera.
- b. Ex-officio member Howard asked about the challenge of leasing office space in the City.
- c. Chair Thomas reminded the commissioners that EDAC terms are expiring for a couple members and that interviews are August 21 & 22.

G. STAFF UPDATE

a. Peggy Flynn provided a general update about some properties in Novato such as the Macy's furniture site stating that Sports Basement had recently signed a lease and will likely be a tenant in Spring 2018. She also provided an update on work that staff is doing to continue attracting bioscience to Novato.
