V. STAFF CONCERNS

- Shigoli stated that Buder is resigning from the Streetscape Committee and that she needs to put her resignation in writing to the Streetscape Committee and the Council.
- Hanna inquired if we need to wait until summer to replace her, but Stompe stated that we do not.
- Stompe stated that she had asked for an alternate to be appointed which would be in March. Stompe also stated there will now be 2 available slots to be appointed.
- Hanna asked if we need to make it more specific when people are interested in joining the Streetscape Committee.
- Basalla commented that she let Terrie Gillen know that it would be beneficial to have people come to the Streetscape meetings before joining.
- Hanna stated that they have a new volunteer that is a San Marin high school student and is a member of the Conservation Corp.? Club?

VI. COMMITTEE MEMBERS' COMMENT TIME

- Basalla commented that she made up an initial list of ground covers to use instead of Round Up. Basalla stated
 Charlotte Torgovitsky, who has donated about \$280.00 worth of plants had asked Basalla to bring up at the meeting
 that she has a nursery propagation and is working on expanding it and could grow plants for the city in her nursery.
- Basalla stated in the California Native Plants Society Newsletter they had a small part saying that the City of Novato uses native plants in traffic islands.
- Hanna asked Shigoli if the broken sprinkler head on Basalla's island had been repaired, and Shigoli stated that it had been fixed.
- Schulze complimented Shigoli on the hard work that the Public Works Department did on Redwood Blvd.
- Stompe stated that she has lost some data on her computer and needs help with sending out postcards from the list.

VII. SUBCOMMITTEE REPORTS

Clean & Green Day

- Next Clean & Green Day Meeting is at Susan Stompe's house on January 17th at 7:00 pm.
- Basalla stated that Joni DeGabriel will be coming to the meeting.
- Stompe stated that the Sanitary District will pay for 2 big posters for Clean & Green Day.
- Schulze stated that the Centric lawn sign update labels will be \$67.25 for 28 signs. Schulze also stated that we have 3 vinyl banners which would be \$15.00 a piece, total is \$45.00. The total would be \$121.80 lawn signs and 3 vinyl banners. Schulze stated that once the invoice comes in, he will submit it.
- Stompe stated she received a quote for the Banner from Centric Signs and was looking into updating banner from a photograph of old sign.
- Shigoli stated he has the old Banner and Stompe and Shigoli agreed that Shigoli will bring it to the next meeting.
- Schulze stated that Bank of Marin is covering the printing of the postcards. The postage is covered by the City for mailing.
- Schulze asked Shigoli if he purchased more garbage grabbers. Shigoli stated that he has purchased 40 out of the Clean & Green money.

Signs

- Schulze asked Shigoli if we received paperwork for a median from Larry Paulger.

Business Landscape Recognition

Island/Site Adoption

Stompe stated they would be reviewing the islands periodically among the committee and will get a list together to hand out as to what islands everyone is assigned to monitor.
- Basalla stated that she and Maggie Rufo cleaned up the Hungary Owl Island, and will get some plants from Charlotte Torgovitsky.

Public Outreach

- Stompe asked Shigoli if the work has been started on the island on Wilson Ave.
- Shigoli stated the work has been started and looks good.

Strategic Planning

- Hanna stated there were 9 volunteers for Team Up To Clean Up for the first Saturday of the month event. Hanna stated there was a father and a daughter from San Marin who were very enthusiastic, and that they had 3 repeat volunteers.
- Basalla stated that they will send emails out to the volunteers and also connect on Next Door for the next event.
- Hanna stated there was a lot of trash in the lot behind Trader Joe's. Brierley stated that there is a homeless encampment behind the lot in the back and will let Hanna know who the property manager is to contact them.
- Basalla inquired if there was a way to recognize our volunteers, and Shigoli stated that he can ask Heather Hafer with the City of Novato about how to go about that.
- Hanna stated that her, Basalla, and Joni DeGabriel, need to come up with a budget.
- Basalla stated the brochure and the website is in the works.

Financial

- Schulze asked Shigoli if there were any changes in the financials and Shigoli stated there were not.
- Basalla asked when we will see the budget in writing.
- Basalla inquired about the grabbers and Shigoli stated he will purchase them from the \$5,000.
