IV. CITIZENS' TIME TO ADDRESS THE COMMITTEE

Steve and Joy McKeever are volunteers who introduced themselves to the committee. They have been the Team Up to Clean Up couple who have been helping Basalla and Hanna picking up tons of garbage especially along Alameda del Prado area. The McKeever's are from Marin County and are very committed to keeping Novato clean. Mr. McKeever inquired if we could put up signs to deter people from littering and leaving cigarette butts in the street. Clive said he would look into this possibility. The McKeever's would like to see more street sweeping in the streets. The McKeever's along with Basalla and Hanna will be keeping track of how many bags are used to pick up trash for statistical purposes.

V. STAFF CONCERNS

- Heather Hafer was present as our staff guest. Hafer would like the names of the
 businesses who will be recognized at a Council meeting, and recommended this
 recognition be agendized, rather than presented as a public comment. Hafer offered
 to get this item agendized, if someone sends her the business name and preferred
 Council meeting dates.
- Hafer stated she understood that the Streetscape committee requested \$5,000 last year; however, since the account showed a substantial balance, it wasn't approved by the Finance Manager or the City Manager.
- Basalla stated that they spent a lot of time working on a budget that they thought went
 to the Council. Basalla was under the impression that it was approved. Hafer stated
 that she reviewed final budget documents for Fiscal Year 17/18 and also checked in
 with the Finance Supervisor, and there is no evidence of new money being allocated
 to the Streetscape Committee.
- Hafer stated that the City of Novato has started their Fiscal Year 18/19 budget process now and recommended the committee re-submit their request for \$5,000.
- Hafer stated that she understands that the Streetscape committee is revising and updating their Strategic Plan. She stated that Russ Thompson is excited to hear about this progress being made and would like to let the community know what the Streetscape committee has been doing. They would like to see an updated Strategic Plan, and any action motions towards goals and deliverables so that she can let the community know through social media.
- Hafer stated that she is the Public Works Webmaster Liaison who manages all of the Public Works communications. Hafer said she would be happy to feature the Streetscape Committee's work by posting pictures and videos of their work on social media. Hafer can also post pictures to announce volunteers. Currently there's a committee page and a Clean & Green Day dedicated page, but Hafer can look into having more Streetscape Committee information on the City's webpage.
- Basalla will send the information about the Team Up To Clean Up Program, and the Novato CommunityTV video to post on the City's social media platforms.

- Hafer stated that she would be available to meet with the Streetscape Committee to help with branding and web presence.
- Basalla stated that they have suggestions as a committee to the Council for the interview process. They would like to ask specific questions to be on the committee.
- Basalla stated if we get more publicity, we can recruit to be on the committee or just volunteer for different events.
- Hafer will post on social media to recruit volunteers for clean-up events if someone sends her information
- Hafer suggested a Streetscape Committee informational brochure be given to the Council Members before the interview to better acquaint themselves with the committee and its members.

VI. COMMITTEE MEMBERS' COMMENT TIME

• Stompe suggested when we give out the Certificates in a plaque to a business that has been nominated, that we will also be leaving an informational brochure regarding the Streetscape Committee and about Clean & Green Day.

VII. SUBCOMMITTEE REPORTS

Clean & Green Day

- Stompe stated that Schulze will get telephone messages and Hanna will be getting on-line sign-ups.
- Next Clean & Green Training Meeting is at Susan Stompe's house on April 19, 2018 at 7:00 pm.
- Basalla asked the McKeevers if they would be in charge of directing people to their cleaning site.
- Stompe passed out postcards to the committee to help place labels and stamps on the front, and Schulze will place in the mail in early March.
- Schulze brought in the Clean & Green Day flyers and distributed some to the committee to pass out.
- Stompe and Schulze went to Centric Signs to show them the poster which should be ready March 24th.
- Stompe stated that the Art Signs and Banner will be ready to be put up by the 1st of April.
- Stompe will re-format the Group Sign-In Sheet and suggested we assign people a section in Novato to clean up on Clean & Green Day.
- Shigoli brought the old banner to the meeting to show the committee.
- Hanna inquired to Shigoli if he purchased more garbage grabbers, and Shigoli stated that he has purchased 40 out of the Clean & Green money and we should have about 90 total.
- Schulze inquired how many vests we have and Shigoli stated he will take a count.
- Hanna inquired if we had contacted the Novato Schools regarding Clean & Green Day and if we could send them an electronic version.
- Hanna stated she spoke to Tom Brady with the Lyons Club and he said that 4 volunteers
 from his organization would help out with registration at the Clean & Green Day event.
 Hanna also emailed Pat Ecklund and Pam Drew regarding Clean & Green Day and their
 participation the day of the event.

Signs

- The Streetscape Committee will be dividing up the adopted islands so that each person would have about 5-6 islands to monitor to be sure that people were taking care of the islands. They would be reviewing the islands periodically among the committee and will get a list together to hand out as to what islands everyone is assigned to monitor.
- Basalla read all of the Islands on the list and who was responsible in the committee.

Public Outreach

- Stompe stated that Novato CommunityTV were not available in December and January and that we requested to get together with them so they can take pictures of Team Up to Clean Up for a video.
- Stompe stated that Novato CommunityTV will take pictures of newly landscaped islands.

Strategic Planning

- Hanna stated they had a clean-up day in February and got it done in an hour.
- Hanna stated some future goals: Improving outreach through Next Door, City of Novato
 website, and social media, refresh branding materials, increase volunteer participation,
 including high school students in clean-up days, and collecting photos and data.
- Basalla stated that she would like to recognize volunteers and Hafer will be helping the committee with social media posting and on the City of Novato website.
- Hanna suggested to get vests that have the logo "Team Up To Clean-Up" on the back.
- Basalla checked price of business cards at Staples, but will get another price at Costco as well.

Financial

- Schulze stated that he had spent \$48.83 towards island signs.
- Stompe stated she has a bill to submit to Shigoli.
