 committee.
- Janeczko stated she would like to be more involved with public outreach in the community.
- Hanna stated to Janeczko to come up with ideas of what she would like to do with the Novato Streetscape Committee.
- Hanna stated that the committee needs to think about publicity for Clean & Green Day and when at a Team Up To Clean Up day to let the public know who they are.
- Hanna stated she would like to order Novato Streetscape business cards to pass out to the public.
- Hanna stated she would like to hire a Webmaster to manage the Novato Streetscape website.
- Hanna would like to have a potluck in December.
