PROJECT DESIGN WORKSHOP:

2. DESIGN STANDARDS FOR OUTDOOR DINING, PARKLETS, AND EXTERIOR SALES DISPLAYS IN THE DOWNTOWN (RT)

General discussion and input to staff regarding the future development of design standards for Outdoor Dining, Parklets, and Exterior Sales Displays in the Downtown. The Commission's initial input will be included in a report to the City Council for their consideration in providing staff direction in developing design standards at the City Council's October 9, 2018 regular meeting. Once prepared, draft design standards for Outdoor Dining, Parklets, and Exterior Sales Displays in the Downtown will be brought back to the Commission for its formal recommendation to City Council.

<u>Public Works Director, Russell Thompson</u>, introduced the effort to establish standards and design guidelines for Outdoor Dining, Parklets, and Exterior Sales Displays in the Downtown and presented a PowerPoint including examples for said features in other municipalities. Thompson clarified this workshop is for initial feedback, namely clarification on the purpose, scope and content of guidelines.

Commission feedback:

Agree with need for guidelines.

A primary "driver" for outdoor space is food, and beverage service.

Need for standards/compatibility in design, including but not limited to: decking size and dimensions e.g. conform with width of store front

decking material(s)

railing (mainly open to through views)

planters

shade features

furniture

colors

lighting, and signs, if allowed

Creative options to standards should be permitted subject to a design review process.

Coordinate bike parking and pet areas.

Consider addressing outdoor entertainment opportunities and restrictions – namely noise management.
