Grant Avenue between Eighth Street and Virginia Avenue in Novato, California

Rehabilitate and widen the existing bridge over Novato Creek, and stabilize the banks and channel on the upstream portion of Novato Creek to minimize scouring of bridge foundations. The existing bridge (Caltrans Bridge No. 27C0021) was built in 1936 and is structurally sound. By current standards, the existing bridge is not wide enough to carry vehicular, bicycle and pedestrian traffic.
