1. Manager's Report. Recreation Services Manager Kevin Conklin shared that the Dogbone Meadow Reopening Ceremony was a success. Mr. Conklin highlighted the upcoming winter events and reported about Margaret Todd Senior Center's booth at the Marin Senior Information Fair and the positive feedback they received from fairgoers. Mr. Conklin notified the Commission that the PRCS department will be doing a fee study and raising rental rates of parks, fields, gyms and facility rentals. The proposed rate increases will be brought to the Commission for approval. Recreation Services Manager Liz Tran updated the Commission on the Multicultural Advisory Commission status. As decided by Council, MAC will remain separate from RCCS, the staff liaison for MAC has changes from Police to Parks and Recreation, and the number of members on MAC is increasing from five to seven.

- 2. <u>CIP Project Updates</u>. Recreation Services Manager Liz Tran gave a CIP Projects Update.
  - **Dogbone Meadows:** Ms. Tran reiterated that the Reopening Ceremony was a success and added that the park has been very busy all week.
  - **Hill Master Plan:** The environmental documents are being circulated and the constructions documents are in progress.
    - i. Chair Weber asked if there will be additional restrooms built. Mr. Conklin explained that the restrooms in the Hill Gymnasium will be accessible to field and court users.
  - Community Garden: Staff met with Novato Live Well Network and confirmed that they are ready to focus on fundraising. The license agreement between the City and Novato Live Well Network is in progress.
    - Chair Weber asked if the Community Garden will be brought back to the RCCS Commission and what their rates for the plots would be. Ms. Tran said that there will be presentations in the future with updates about the garden. Ms. Tran also explained that Novato Live Well Network does not have rates established yet.



# **REQUEST**

Receive a report by the Public Works Department regarding the Hill Recreation Area, (Capital Improvement Project), CIP # 01-005

# **DISCUSSION**

On April 10, 2018, the Novato City Council voted unanimously to approve the general scope of the proposed "Hill Recreation Area Hub." Key elements included in the Hub are an expanded synthetic turf area with gravel overflow parking along with a consolidated bocce ball and pickleball area that meet the needs for these community priorities. Construction of the Hill Recreation Area Hub is aligned with community desires and allows for the prioritized elements of the project to be implemented within the budget and without precluding future improvements. Gates & Associates has been hired to prepare construction plans, specifications, and detailed estimate.

A Public Hearing was held to consider and take action to adopt a Mitigated Negative Declaration and a Mitigation Monitoring Program under the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA).

#### FISCAL IMPACT

This project is estimated to cost approximately \$7,228,000
