

CITY OF NOVATO NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

AMENDMENTS TO THE NOVATO MUNICIPAL CODE AMENDING SECTION 19.34.030 (ACCESSORY DWELLING UNITS) OF CHAPTER XIX (ZONING) TO: A) MAINTAIN CONSISTENCY WITH STATE LAW RELEVANT TO ADUS, INCLUDING PARKING REQUIREMENTS; B) EXEMPT PUBLIC AGENCIES AND NON-PROFIT HOUSING ORGANIZATIONS FROM AN OWNER-OCCUPANCY REQUIREMENT CURRENTLY APPLIED TO ADUS; AND C) OTHER AMENDMENTS TO CLARIFY EXISTING STANDARDS. THE PROPOSED AMENDMENTS ARE EXEMPT FROM THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT (CEQA) PURSUANT TO CEQA GUIDELINES SECTION 15282(h) – OTHER STATUTORY EXEMPTIONS.

Notice is hereby given that the Novato Planning Commission will hold a public hearing on **Monday**, **July 8**, **2019**, **at 7:00pm** in Novato City Hall, 901 Sherman Avenue, Novato, California to provide a recommendation to the City Council regarding a proposal to amend the Novato Municipal Code including the following:

- Maintain consistency with state law relevant to ADUs, including parking requirements;
- Exempt public agencies and non-profit housing organizations from an owner-occupancy requirement currently applied to ADUs; and
- Other amendments to clarify existing standards.

Comments received on or before the public hearing date will be considered by the Planning Commission.

If anyone wishes to challenge this project in court, they may be limited to raising only those issues they or anyone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice or in written correspondence delivered to the Community Development Department on, or prior to, the hearing date.
