NEW BUSINESS

I. AGENDA ITEMS

- **a.** Discussion of PARB's mission and purpose. (Chief McGill)
 - i. Council and City are reviewing all City of Novato commissions to determine if they are still relevant and purposeful.
 - **ii.** Chief McGill proposes to dissolve PARB, keep existing grievance processing through the City Manager and department head, and in its place

form a 15 person Police Chief Advisory Board that meets quarterly, involves underrepresented community groups and follows a less formal meeting model as implemented by cities including San Leandro and Vallejo.

- **iii.** PARB members strongly in favor of keeping the independent civilian oversight and appeal roles of PARB in addition to meeting on a regular basis even if just quarterly.
- iv. A request for ongoing exposure and training in department policy, procedures, and activities was made. Motion was made, and passed unanimously, to recommend endorsing the Chief's proposal, only by making PARB members ex-officio members of the Chief's community board, while keeping the PARB's duties and functions intact.
- v. Review of Brown Act and formation of subcommittee may be necessary.
