

F. PRESENTATIONS

Recreation Supervisor, Alexandra Kambur presented an update on the Novato Gymnastics Center. Highlights of her presentation included that the Gymnastics Center is home to 10 permanent and approximately 20 part-time staff. They offer preschool, recreational and competitive opportunities to children from 12 months through 18 years, along with several day camps throughout the year. The Gymnastics Center serves 800 participants per week, with more than 85% girls. They host two large Competitive Meets per year in addition to a Summer and Holiday Show.

Results from their annual program survey were shared. 94% of respondents believe the facility is clean and well-maintained. 99% of respondents would recommend Novato Gymnastics to a friend or family member. 96% of respondents believe customer service provided by front office staff is responsive. 94% of children enjoy coming to the Novato Gymnastics Center. 93% of respondents believe that their child's instructor is knowledgeable about gymnastics and qualified to teach at the respective level.

Awards won recently include the 2019 Pacific Sun Best Indoor Children's Facility in Marin County and the Downtown Novato Business Association's 'Most Locally Inspired' Window Decorating Contest.

Ms. Kambur handed out invitations to each Commissioner inviting them to the 20th Anniversary Celebration on October 19.
