- a. You will be asked to enter an email address and name. We request that you identify yourself by name as this will be visible online and will be used to notify you when it is your turn to speak.
 - b. When the Chair calls for public comment on the item on which you wish to speak, “raise hand.” To “raise your hand,” click on the participant’s icon (looks like a human figure) and a list of all the participants pops up on the right-hand side. When you see your name, right click your name, and a hand appears. Select the hand to change the color to blue, so that you can be seen as raising your hand.
 - c. The host will activate and unmute speakers in turn. Speakers will be notified that it is now their turn to speak.
 - d. When called, please limit your remarks to the time limit allotted. The speakers will be muted again when time is up.
- Listen only participation may be accessed by calling toll number (415) 655-0002 and entering access code #173 243 268. **Please note you will not be able to provide public comment during the meeting using this number – this is a “listen only” participation method.**
