D. PUBLIC COMMENTS

The committee members commented that they drove through the locations prior to the meeting and agree that all the locations could use some help and are in favor of the all-way stops. There were 6 residents that spoke, and all were in favor of the all-way stops at Bolling Circle. The common concerns brought up by several was in addition to the high speeds, there is a lack of parking at the Bay Vista apartment complex which in turn forces vehicles to park along Bolling which creates a site distance issue along with the fact that is a steep hill. This issue seems to be more prevalent in the evenings when people arrive home from work. People also continue to ignore existing signage and hydrants when parking. It was also suggested that enforcement and education will need to be a key part of the solution.
