Monday, January 10, 2022 - 7:00pm Meeting held via Zoom Teleconference

A. CALL TO ORDER AND ROLL CALL

Meeting began at 7:02pm.

E. STAFF UPDATES

E.1 Review of City Council Commissions, Committees, and Boards

- Director Blunk stated that re-structuring the Committee to become a volunteer group supported by the Public Works Department is not an option. Three other options discussed were:
 - 1) Becoming a decentralized group of volunteers similar to Clean Mill Valley; or
 - 2) Becoming an independent 501c3 nonprofit organization; or
 - 3) Remaining a Committee of the City Council.

- A review of City Council Commissions, Committees, and Boards will be heard by the Council on January 25, 2022. It was agreed that staff would not be recommending any changes to the structure of the Committee at this time. However, staff and Committee members will continue to explore options to efficiently and effectively support the Committee's volunteer efforts.
- Director Blunk noted that funding allocated to the Committee cannot be accrued from one year to the next. Going forward, the Committee will prepare an annual funding request of up to \$5,000 as part of the City's annual budget process. If the Committee identifies a specific project requiring more than the \$5,000, a request can be submitted during the budget planning process for consideration by the Council.
- At the Council meeting on January 25, 2022, staff will seek Council approval to allocate the accrued funding to the landscape improvement project on Redwood Blvd proposed by the Committee.
- Temple asked about the adoption of a new mission statement for the Committee.
 Director Blunk noted that amending the purpose or mission of Council Commissions,
 Committees, and Boards is at the discretion of the Council.
- Basalla would like more support from City staff to promote the activities of the Committee. Director Blunk suggested adding a standing agenda item to discuss specific projects/events that the Committee would like help publicizing.

- Illegal dumping of bulky items is a big problem on Alameda del Prado.
- Director Blunk will discuss options with the City's traffic engineer to deter (or at least make it more difficult) to carry out illegal dumping activities.
