DRAFT OBJECTIVE DEVELOPMENT & DESIGN STANDARDS P2021-077; DESIGN REVIEW 773, 775, & 777 SAN MARIN DRIVE; APNs 125-202-03, -04, & -05

Conduct a public hearing to consider making a recommendation to the Planning Commission and City Council regarding draft objective development and design standards for redevelopment of 773, 775, and 777 San Marin Drive (former Fireman's Fund campus) into a residential community, focusing on standards addressing site design, common open space areas and amenities, building height and mass, and architecture.

Such materials shall also be made available on the City of Novato website at novato.org when practical and provided that City staff is able to post those documents prior to the meeting. Also, when non-confidential written materials are distributed to members of the Design Review Commission during a public meeting by staff or a member of the Design Review Commission, copies shall be made available to members of the public following that meeting.
