


Dear Neighbor,

We have some important information to share with you about an upcoming project in your neighborhood. Improvements are being made to the Grant Avenue Bridge between 8th Street and Virginia Avenue. Benefits of this project include widened roadway access, safety improvements for pedestrians, bicyclists and motorists, new bridge railing and pavement as well as new signage and a street light system.

After almost 15 years of planning, design development and funding acquisition, work is expected to begin in early April with road closures anticipated in early May. Construction is expected to be completed by January 2025.

During construction, the pedestrian pathway will remain available as we understand the importance of maintaining pedestrian access to and from downtown Novato. However, vehicular traffic will be impacted by construction, and detours will be in place as needed. We encourage you to use alternate routes during these times.

We're looking forward to making these much-needed improvements to your roadway, and appreciate your patience and understanding while construction is being completed.
