 - Police: Safety, Emergency Services
 - Economic Development Manager and Hamilton Base Reuse Manager:
 Economic Development and Economic forecasts
 - Planning: Land Use, Development forecasts, Environment, EIR,
 Departmental Liaisons

- Selective Use of Consultants:
 - EIR
 - Greenhouse Gas Emission Reduction Calculations
 - Document Design and Graphics









An Inclusive Document

- Incorporate Downtown Specific Plan
 - Edited version, eliminating actions accomplished and correcting inconsistencies
- Incorporate Climate Action Plan
 - Include as "call-outs" in several elements,
 - Update with 2010 Emissions Inventory, and
 - Recalculate greenhouse gas emission reductions

2. EIR

- Draft EIR
- Public Review Period
- Planning Commission Meeting on Draft EIR
- Response to Comments
- Preparation of Final EIR









Schedule: Three Phases

3. Adoption

- Boards & Commissions Review and Recommendations
- Planning Commission Hearing and Recommendations on Final EIR and Draft General Plan
- City Council Certification of Final EIR and Adoption of General Plan









Schedule: Expediting N. Redwood

- EIR required for adoption of land use changes
- Can achieve Council direction after Phase I, so owners/developers can pursue applications and CEQA review
- Inextricably linked with North, North Redwood corridor (north of San Marin)
- Currently processing applications for 20% of North Redwood study area
- Chamber of Commerce & Econ. Dev. Advisory
 Committee recommend a moratorium
